- 시상대상 : 대한민국과 프랑스 간 공동의 학술적 업적과 양측 간의 협력을 더욱 증진시키기 위한 실질적인 선행협력관계를 가진 대한민국 연구기관 상근(정규) 직위 연구자 1명과 프랑스 연구기관 상근(정규) 직위 연구자 1명으로 구성된 현역 연구자 한 팀
 - ※ 대한민국학술원과 프랑스과학아카데미 회원은 제외
- 시상부문 : 모든 학문 분야(실험, 형식, 인문·사회과학 포함)
- 시상인원 : 1팀(2명 이내)
- 선정방법 : 양국 학술원 회원으로 구성(각 3명씩)된 심사위원회에서 심사·선정
- 시상내용 : 상금 30,000유로(한화 약 5,100만 원)
 - ※ 상금구성(학술상 수상자에게 각 5,000유로, 주관 아카데미의 관리하에 양측 수상자의 연구지속성을 위한 연구지원금으로 20,000유로 지급)

2026 – Call for Applications OPEN TO ALL RESEARCH FIELDS AND THEIR APPLICATIONS

The Académie des sciences and The National Academy of Sciences (NAS) of the Republic of Korea will jointly award in 2026 a Scientific Prize aimed at highlighting the role of scientific collaboration in bilateral relations by celebrating the achievements it has enabled and fostering their continuation.

The Prize will be awarded to a pair of active researchers (one holding a permanent position at a Korean research institution and the other holding a permanent position at a French research institution) in recognition of their joint scientific achievements, and for their commitment to further enhancing their cooperation.

In 2026, the Académie des sciences and The National Academy of Sciences, Republic of Korea will jointly award a prize endowed with

30 000€ in prize money.

(divided as follows : 5 000€ for each Laureate and 20 000€ dedicated to foster collaborative research activities)

Selection Process

- The call is open to all research fields and their applications.
- Candidates teams are required to complete together the Application form attached to this call and available on [this link](#).

- Applicants must hold a PhD
- Applications must be submitted by a team of 2 researchers:
 - one holding a permanent position at a Korean research institution; and
 - one holding a permanent position at a French research institution.
- The 2 researchers must have an **established and effective prior collaboration**, demonstrated through joint research activities and outcomes, and projects aimed at enhancing it.
- Letter of support:
Each application must include at least **1 and no more than 2** letters of support from distinguished or internationally recognized scientists within the applicant's field.

Note that recommendation letter(s) is/are to be directly emailed to the Académie des sciences and The National Academy of Sciences, by the referees themselves, in PDF format with the mandatory subject:

"2026 Franco-Korean Prize: LAST NAMES" (of both applicants).

Recommendation letter(s) must be received **no later than 21st September 2026**.

Late or improperly submitted letters will not be considered.

- Members from Académie des sciences or the National Academy of Sciences are not eligible to apply for the Prize.

21st September 2026



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Evaluation Criteria

Applications will be evaluated on 1) Scientific excellence, 2) Originality and impact of the joint research, and 3) Potential for future scientific cooperation between France and Korea.

Evaluation Procedure

The selection of the Applicants is based on the above-mentioned criteria and carried out by a Jury composed of an equal number of Academicians with a minimum of 3 appointed from each side, selected for their scientific expertise and their familiarity with the research areas relevant to the applications. Decisions are taken by an absolute majority.

Announcement of Results and Award Ceremony

The prize will be awarded in December 2026.
